Iguazu Falls Post-Trip Available

27 May - Arrival to CUIABÁ, BRAZIL

Arrive to Cuiaba, Brazil anytime this day. Reception at the airport and transfer to hotel in Cuiabá – check in time is in the afternoon.

28 May - CUIABÁ to PANTANAL

After breakfast, departure from the hotel in Cuiabá to the Pantanal, arrival to a hotel, at the km 65 - halfway of the total of the Transpantaneira park-road length. Lunch. In the afternoon a boat ride along the small Pixaim river, in order to familiarize our eyes to see the first birds, mammals and reptiles.

Accommodation: Mato Grosso Pantanal or similar

29 May – PANTANAL - Porto Jofre – Jaguar Search

Breakfast & transfer down the Transpantaneira (searching for wildlife along the way) until its end on the Cuiabá river banks, in Porto Jofre, with arrival for lunch. In the afternoon, we have our first experience seeking Jaguars on a fast speed boat ride. Dinner and overnight.

Accommodation: Pousada Dona Onça or similar

30 May- PANTANAL - Jaguar Search

The whole day (since very early) is devoted to observe Jaguars by boat.

31 May – PANTANAL

After breakfast, we depart from Porto Jofre all the way up to the Piuval lodge, located at a very diversified environment. After many stops to observe rich variety of wildlife and lunch in the middle of the way, arrival to the lodge right on time to do the check-in and, few minutes later, do a nice jeep and night safaris through the fields.

1 & 2 June - PANTANAL

. In the early morning, we do an Overland safari through the Termites mound-hills, trying to see the Giant Anteater. Breakfast and, in the morning, we visit a remote stream with a large concentration of birds, many caimans and some otters. In the afternoon, we do an overland safari through the fields and forests, on the Jaguar territory, with large possibility of seeing the Americas' third largest cat.

3 June – Return to Cuiaba

In the early morning, we do an Overland safari through the Termites mound-hills, trying to see the Giant Anteater. After breakfast, we leave the Pantanal to Cuiabá, with drop-off at the convenient time. (optional) Continue on to Iguazu Extension.

3 June – Arrival to Iguazu

Reception at the airport and transfer to a nice and tranquil hotel in Foz do Iguaçu city.

Included: Dinner

4 June – IGUAZU - Brazilian Side

Transportation and guided tour following the Cataratas highway, arriving at Iguassu National Park after about 30 minutes. Created in 1939 and covering 185.000 hectares, the ecological reserve has been declared part of the Natural Humanity Heritage by UNESCO and, recently, the title of one of the 07 World wonders. Following the walkways that border the canyon of the Iguassu River, is possible to observe hundreds of small waterfalls until where the last Floriano Falls is reached. There, a complete frontal view of Devil's Throat can be seen. Lunch at Porto Canoas Restaurant. On the way back, stop scheduled for shopping at local crafts centre.

Hotel: Charm Hotel Iguassu or similar

5 June – Iguazu – Argentina Side

Transportation and guided tour leaving the Brazil/Argentina border and reaching Argentina through the Tancredo Neves bridge, crossing over the Iguassu River. After one hour driving, the 55.500 hectares reserve is plenty of trails that provide the pleasure of a different, more complete and magnificent view of the falls, specially the biggest one - the Devil's Throat. Lower and upper walkways permit a closer look at the waterfalls. The afternoon is free, with our suggestion to do a Gran Aventura Safari – a boat ride from the bottom of the falls or – if taking an in box lunch – do longer trails to admire the rich fauna of the Atlantic Rain Forest environment.
